- All yardages are to the center of the green.
- Hole locations: Red Flag denotes front of green. Yellow Flag denotes middle. Blue Flag denotes back of green.
- Carts must return to the cart path at **least** 10 yards from the greens and must remain on the path. Golfers may walk around the greens and teeing area. Please do not walk out of the natural grass areas.
- Cart path only on all Par 3's.
- Push carts are not permitted on tees, fairways, greens, or between the bunkers and greens.
- Please fill your divots, fix ball marks, and maintain the bunkers with the rake provided.

- No carry on food, beverages, or coolers.
- Proper golf attire required.
- No more than 2 carts per foursome.
- Each player must have their own golf bag.
- Rental sets are available in the Golf Shop.

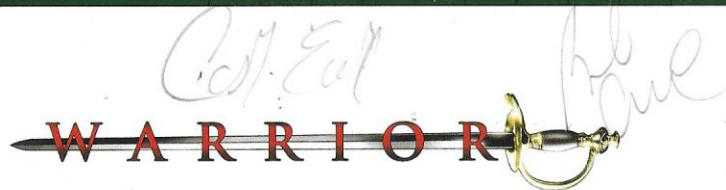

- Red stakes define red penalty areas. In the absence of red stakes the "higher grass cut" or tree line defines the red penalty area. Native grass areas are not to be played as a red penalty area.

Course Information

- All yardages are to the center of the green.
- Hole locations: Red Flag denotes front of green, Blue Flag denotes middle, White Flag denotes back.
- Carts must return to the cart path at least 10 feet from the greens and must remain on the cart path around the greens and teeing area. Please do not drive out of the natural grass areas.
- Cart path only on all Par 3's.
- Push carts are not permitted on tees, fringes, greens, or between the bunkers and greens.
- Please fill your divots, fix ball marks, and rake bunkers with the rake provided.

Course Policies

- No carry on food, beverages, or coolers.
- Proper golf attire required.
- No more than 2 carts per foursome.
- Each player must have their own golf bag.
- Rental sets are available in the Golf Shop.
